Die Urheber stürzt dieses Verhalten in ein Dilemma. Theoretisch haben sie rechtliche Mittel, um sich gegen Urheberrechtsverletzungen zu wehren. Praktisch machen sie davon jedoch nur in Extremfällen Gebrauch, um ihre Fans nicht zu verlieren. Das Phänomen der Fan Art ist damit Teil eines Problems, das in Rechtswissenschaft und Politik zunehmend diskutiert wird: Kann das geltende Urheberrecht im Zeitalter der Remixkultur die Interessen von Urhebern und kreativen Werknutzern noch zu einem gerechten Ausgleich führen? Die Arbeit geht dieser Frage nach und entwickelt anhand anschaulicher Beispiele aus der Welt der Fan Art einen Vorschlag für einen Interessenausgleich, der bereits durch das geltende Recht erzielt werden kann.
