Examining the young adult horror series and the religious horror series for children (Left Behind: The Kids) for the first time, and tracing the

unstoppable monster to Seuss's Cat in the Hat, this book sheds new light on the problematic message produced by the combination of marketing and books for contemporary American young readers.
